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## Potter Valley Rodeo Scholarship

Dear Scholarship Applicant,

The Potter Valley Rodeo Scholarship was established by the Potter Valley Rodeo Committee to financially assist Potter Valley High School Seniors further their education by attending a trade school or college. The scholarship will be awarded based on the student's contribution to their school, our community, their success at school, extra curricular activities and their likelihood of success. Once awarded, in order to receive the scholarship you must be enrolled in a trade school, junior college, college, or university. The semester or quarter must be completed with 12 or more units and you must hold a 2.5 GPA or greater.

### Instructions:

When you submit your application, it must be accompanied by the following items:

- Official high school transcripts
- Information about trade school (if applicable)
- Two letters of recommendation

All items must be included in your scholarship application packet. If any of these items are missing you will NOT BE CONSIDERED.

Letters of recommendation: Only **one of the two letters** can come from a teacher or school administrator. A parent or close relative cannot be considered as a reference. The name and occupation of the person writing the letter of recommendation is required.

The scholarship application and all required materials must be completed and mailed to Potter Valley Rodeo, PO Box 68, Potter Valley, CA 95469 by the **May 1st** deadline. Application packets postmarked after May 1st will not be considered.
